

## **Hating What God Hates**

## "Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good." (Romans 12:9)

- 1. Have genuine love from a heart filled with God's Word.
- 2. Although God is love, His love hates all that is evil. (Hebrews 1:8-9)
- 3. Hatred can be a Christian virtue when directed at Satan and the evils of the world. Hatred can be righteous.
  - a. Righteousness hates as much as it loves.
  - b. We hate evil while loving the evil person.
  - c. The Jesus who died for the evil person hates and will destroy the evil they created and operated in.
  - d. Jesus hates those who hate righteousness and loves those who love righteousness.
- 4. God & Jesus both believe in and use capital punishment. Noah's flood, Tower of Babel, Sodom & Gomorrah, and Armageddon to come.
- 5. For hating lawlessness there is commendation by God:
  - a. An anointing of the oil of gladness for proper hatred.
  - b. God's gladness is His reward for your proper hatred.
- 6. Jesus was hated by Satan, demons, and the religious people of His day.
  - a. They hated Jesus because they hated righteousness.
  - b. Jesus had much to say about religion and His hatred for it in Matthew 23:4-5, 13-15, 25.
  - c. Jesus threw the moneychangers, tables, and product out of God's house. His disciples recalled scripture of how the deal of the Lord would consume Jesus.
- 7. The day is coming when Jesus will return to earth and cast off and destroy all that is evil and those who are evil.
- 8. God has asked us to also hate that which is evil as we live to imitate God Himself.

- 3. God hates it when His own people come into His presence with false acts of worship and hypocrisy. (Isaiah 1:11-16; Amos 5:21-23)

## An Outline Of Evil God Hates

- 1. God hates all evildoers.
- 2. He hates all arrogance and ways of evil.

- 3. He hates perverted speech.
- 4. He hates divorce to simply put away a mate.
- 5. He hates the false oath.
- 6. He hates covetousness.
