

Matthew 24 – 25 Part 3

Jesus Taught About the Seventieth Week

- 1. Matthew 21:23 Jesus no longer cared to skirt the issue with the Pharisees. He openly faced them in questions and answers until the end of chapter 22 which says "...nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore."
- 2. Matthew 21:33-46 Treatment of Old Testament prophets. The kingdom will be taken from Israel and given to the Gentiles.
- 3. Matthew 22:1-14 Jesus gave a second parable, how both Jews and Gentiles will be at the marriage feast.
- 4. Matthew 23:1-36 Jesus rebuked the Pharisees for their hypocrisy.
- 5. Matthew 23:37-39 Jesus cried over Jerusalem.
- 6. Matthew 24:1 Jesus turned away from Jerusalem to turn toward the Gentiles.
- 7. Romans 11:25 When the Church Age is over, Israel returned to being the custodians of the gospel and the Word of God.

"Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down."

Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?" (Matthew 24:1-3)

Jesus Answered Three Questions:

- 1. "When will these things be?" The siege of Jerusalem (Luke 21:20-24).
- 2. "What will be the sign of Your coming?" (Matthew 24:27-51)
- 3. "What shall be the sign of the end of the age?" (Matthew 24-26)
