

Matthew 24 – 25 Part 8

The Millennium

1. Perfect environment because Satan is bound and there is not religion on the earth (Revelation 20:1-3).
2. There will be maximum spirituality in Millennium (Joel 2:28-29, Isaiah 65:24, Zechariah 14:16-17)
3. We will finally have the peace of Jerusalem. Until then Israel is under discipline (Isaiah 5:26-30, 10:19-23, 11:11-16, 65:19, Joel 2:16, Zechariah 8:20-23, 10:6-12)
4. Fulfillment of the unconditional covenants to Israel (Daniel 9:24).
 - a. Abrahamic
 - b. Palestinian
 - c. Davidic
5. Nations will enjoy perfect environment.
 - a. Universal Peace (Isaiah 2:4, Hosea 2:18, Psalm 46:9, Micah 4:3).
 - b. Universal Prosperity (Psalm 72:7, 16).
 - c. Perfect world government run by the Lord Jesus (Isaiah 11:1-2, Zechariah 14:9).
 - d. Universal knowledge of Jesus Christ (Isaiah 11:9).
 - e. Nature is loosed from its curse (Romans 8:19-22).
 1. Animals will no longer be ferocious (Isaiah 6-9, 65:25).
 2. Plants will abound (Isaiah 35:1-2, 7).
6. There will be perfect environment for mankind
 - a. Longevity is restored to humans (Isaiah 65:20).
 - b. Perfect justice (Isaiah 11:3-5, Psalm 72:12-14).
7. Millennium begins with believers only.
 - a. Jewish unbelievers are removed (Ezekiel 20:34-38).
 - b. Gentile unbelievers are removed (Matthew 25:31-46).
8. Millennium was prophesied in the Old Testament and in the gospels. Jesus gave the platform for the Millennium in the sermon on the mount.
9. The course of the Millennium:
 - a. Prophesied in the Old Testament.
 - b. Proclaimed in the gospels.
 - c. Postponed in the tribulation.
 - d. Plagiarized in the tribulation.
 - e. Presented at the Second Advent.

10. The Millennium is a time of population expansion. Unbelievers will proliferate and at the end, Satan will be released for a short time and there will be a revolution. This indicates that a perfect environment is not the solution to man's problem – it is regeneration (Revelation 20:11-15).

Great White Throne Judgment is After the Millennium

1. Satan, demons, fallen angels, and all unbelievers (Revelation 20:11-15).
2. We will judge sinners and fallen angels with God (1 Corinthians 6:2-3).
