The Four Kinds of Trees

1. Pleasant to the sight.
2. Good for food.
3. The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil.
4. The Tree of Life.

The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil

1. Man ate this tree and died spiritually (Romans 5:12).

The Tree of Life
