The Holy Spirit is With Us and In Us

“And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.” (John 14:16-17)

1. The Holy Spirit is **with** us.
 - a. The Holy Spirit is **with** us at salvation (Hebrews 13:5).
 - b. This is a holdover from Old Testament ministry. Jehovah Shammah.
 - c. The Holy Spirit will always be **with** us (John 14:16, Matthew 28:20).
2. The Holy Spirit is **in** us. Why the Holy Spirit is **in** us.
 - a. The Holy Spirit is **in** us for everlasting life (John 4:13-14).
 - b. The Holy Spirit is **in** us for the assurance of salvation (1 John 4:13).
 - c. The Holy Spirit **in** us is the anointing (1 John 2:27).
 - d. The Holy Spirit makes our body His temple (1 Corinthians 6:19).
3. The Holy Spirit is **on** us (Acts 1:8).
 - a. When the Holy Spirit comes **upon** us, we are given a divine, supernatural language. We speak with tongues.
 - b. He aids our spiritual growth.
 - c. He gives revelation of the word.
 - d. He brings spiritual rest and refreshment.
 - e. He helps us when we do not know how to pray.
 - f. He reveals things to come.
 - g. He brings sensitivity to the will of God.
 - h. He edifies, builds us up on our faith.
 - i. He prepares us to be used in spiritual gives.

The Holy Spirit Came UPON Jesus First, Then Us

“And John bore witness, saying, “I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and He remained upon Him. I did not know Him, but He who sent me to baptize with water said to me, ‘Upon whom you see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, this is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.’” (John 1:32-33)

“And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, “You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased.” (Luke 3:22)

1. This experience began the supernatural in His ministry.
2. Jesus began His public ministry preaching and healing.

The Spirit Wants to Come UPON Us for Power

1. That same experience is for us, His disciples.
2. Joel prophesied we would have the Holy Spirit come upon us (Joel 2:28-29, Acts 2:17-18).
3. Jesus prophesied the same experience would come upon us.
